

Camp Evergreen - October 12-14, 2018

Dear Parents:

We are going to Camp Evergreen near Sundre for the weekend of 12-14 October 2018. Cadets will participate in various outdoor activities including wall climbing, zip lines, archery, air rifle shooting, camping skills and possibly horseback riding and canoeing. Everyone will be staying in a cabin/lodge with heat and bunks, so cadets need only require sleeping bags for sleeping. Food services are provided by camp staff in a dining room.

As this is an outdoor activity camp, cadets must be dressed appropriately for being outside all day long. This includes proper outside foot wear, jacket plus hat and gloves as weather is not predictable.

Cadets will be required to be at the ship by 1615 hrs (4:15 PM) on Friday for kit check and your cadet must eat supper before arriving (or bring for on the bus) as we will not supply supper Friday night.
